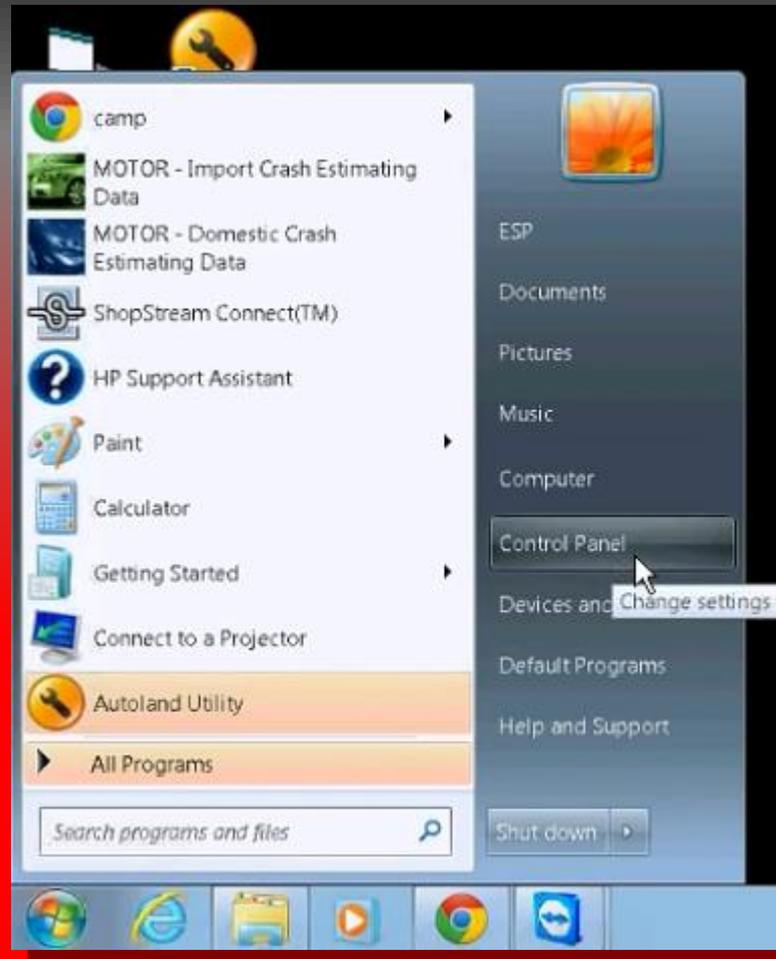
Installing Autoland USB Drivers

Before you begin



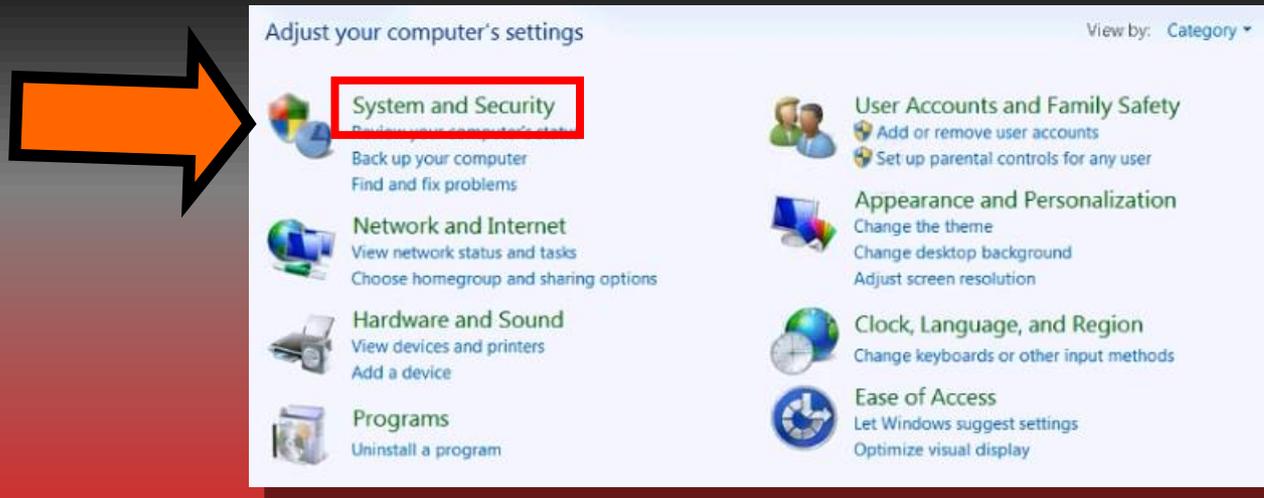
- Ensure Autoland Utility software has already been installed
- If your computer is running Windows 8/10 you may need to Disable Driver Signature Enforcement
 - For a detailed guide please review 'Disabling Driver Signature Enforcement'
- Make sure the scanner is plugged in throughout this entire process
 - Please ensure the scanner is powered off and ONLY connected via USB

1. Click on the **Start** button, then on Control Panel.

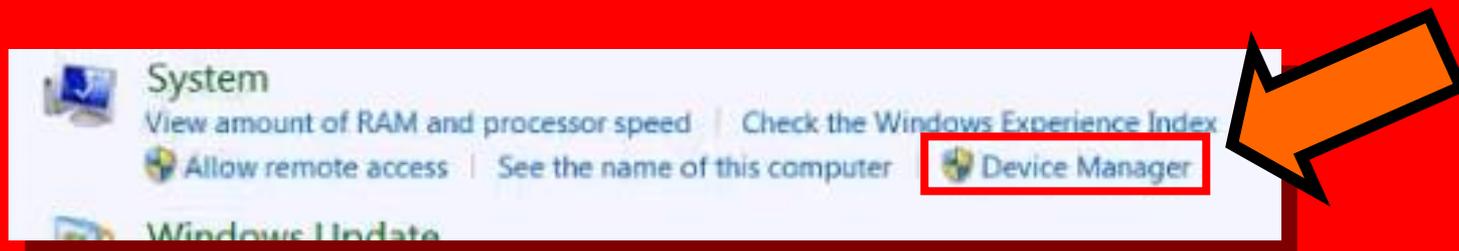


Example shown: Windows 7/Vista

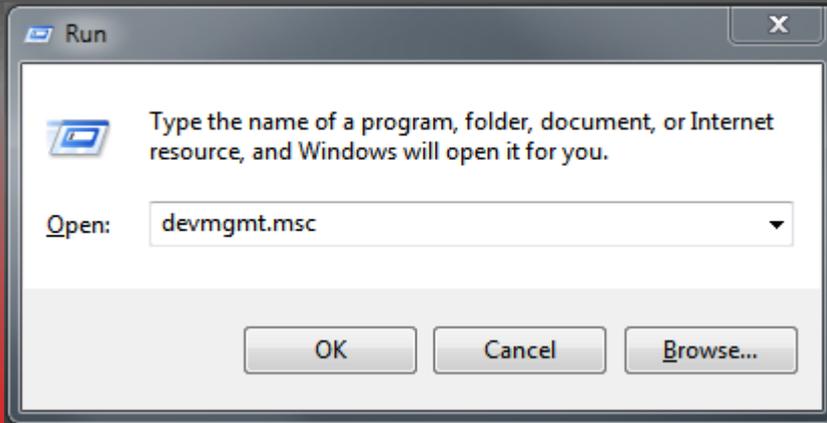
2. On the Control Panel click on System and Security,



3. Then click on Device Manager.



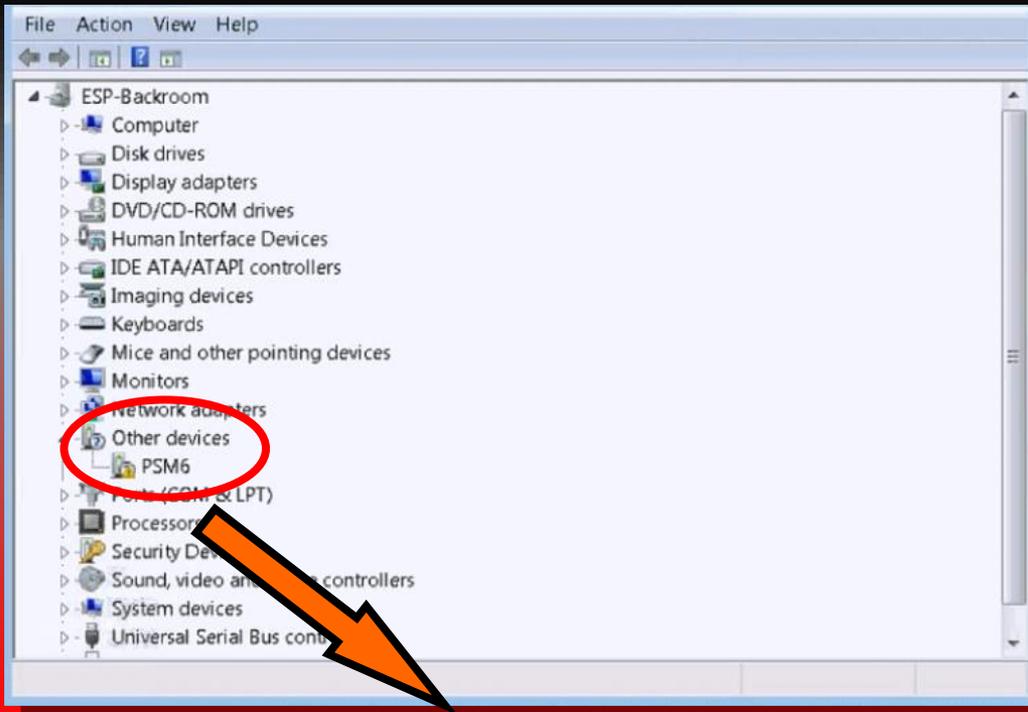
Shortcut to Device Manager



As an alternative, you can also use the Run window to open Device Manager

- **Press the Windows key + 'R'**
- **Open the filename 'devmgmt.msc'**

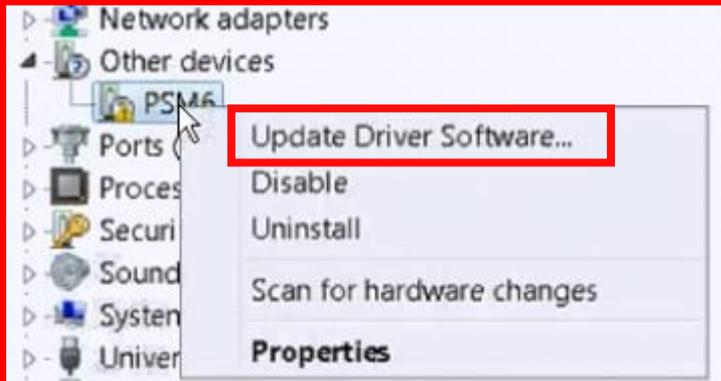
Update Driver Software

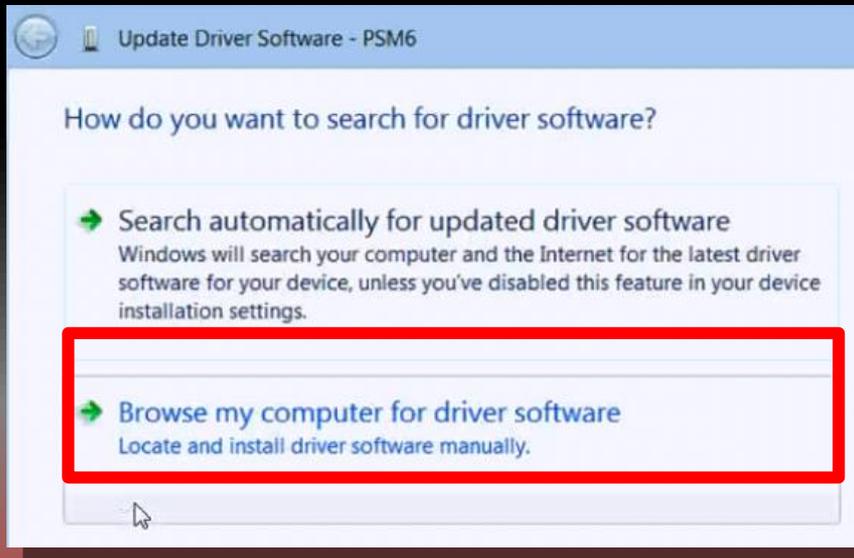


You will see the scanner under Other devices labeled as PSM6 with a warning icon.

We will need to update the driver - right click on it and select

‘Update Driver Software’



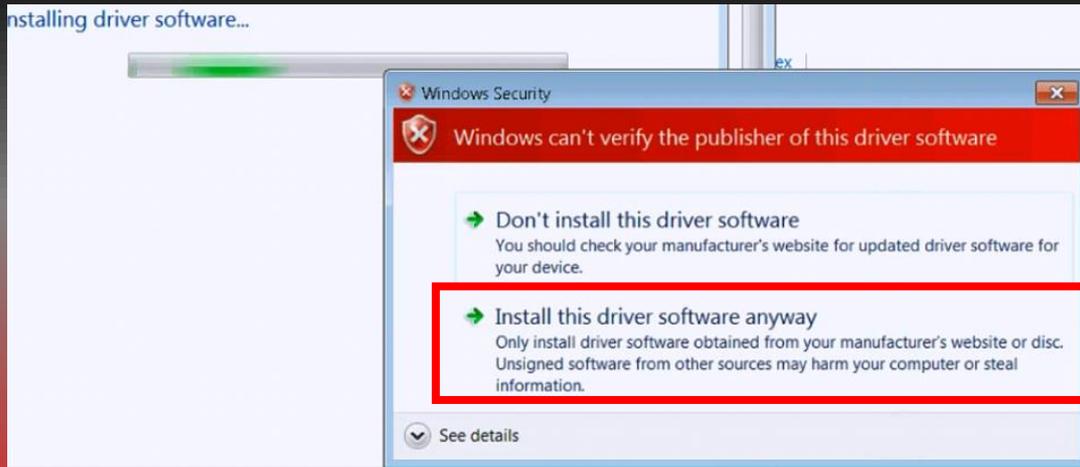


- Choose the option to 'Browse my computer for driver software'
- Browse to the directory C:\PSModule\PSM_DRIVER

*** Check the box 'Include subfolders'

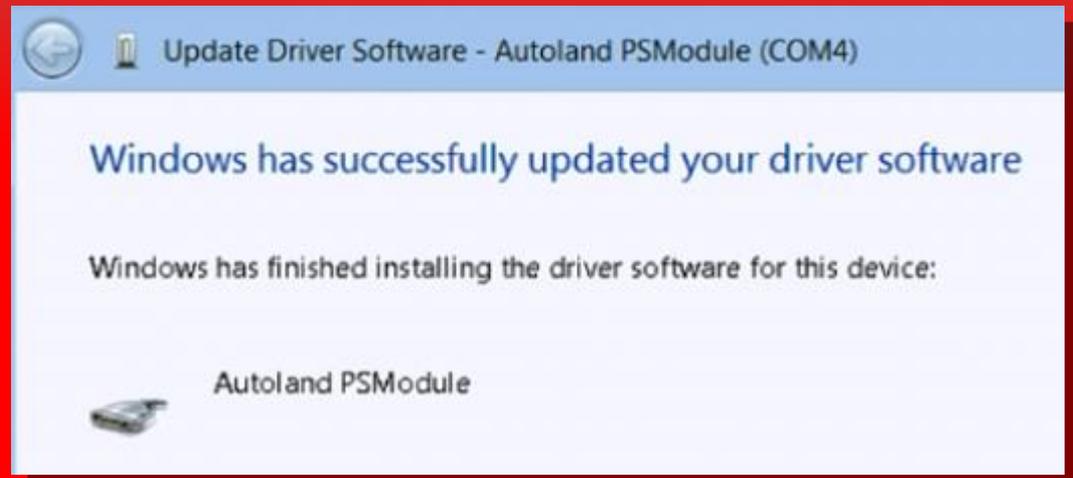


Install driver software



When prompted by Windows, choose **Install this driver software anyway**.

When you see this screen, the driver has been updated and you are ready to connect.



Conclusion

- If Device Manager does not list the scanner
 - Please ensure the scanner is powered off and **ONLY** connected via USB
- If Driver Signature Enforcement was disabled please restart the computer after you have completed all the steps
 - This will Enable Driver Signature Enforcement
